Dear colleagues,

Since the first report on the fossil reptiles from the Late Triassic of Guanling, Guizhou Province, in China in 1999, the Triassic marine vertebrate faunas of Guizhou, including the Guanling Biota, the Panxian Fauna and the Xingyi Fauna, have been attracting greater interests from scientists all over the world. Research on these faunas featured prominently at the 2nd IPC and at the 64th, 65th, 66th, 67th, 68th SVP meetings. To provide an opportunity to review progress of research in recent years, and to further discuss the Triassic marine vertebrates from Guizhou Province, "The International Symposium on Triassic and later Marine Faunas, Guanling" will be held in Guanling County on August 2009, sponsored by the Anshun Government, Land and Resources Department of Guizhou Province and Peking University.

The main topic of the symposium is: "Triassic marine faunas in southwestern China: The evolution, paleogeography, paleoenvironment, paleoecology and the response to the recovery of the Triassic biosphere". This is augmented by the overview of the evolution of marine vertebrates after the Triassic. A discussion forum will be held around Triassic Paleontology and interrelated subjects such as the construction of a Geopark, the development of a museum, the organization of international cooperation and talent cultivation.

Post-symposium excursion:

We are planning to arrange four post-symposium excursions that are still under consideration. The tentative excursion routes are as follows:

Route 1: Guanling National Geological Park (recommended)

Route 2: Triassic stratigraphy and marine vertebrate fossil locations (including Huangguoshu Waterfall, Huajiang Canyon and Dragon Palace) in Guizhou Province Route 3: Dingxiao Museum, Wusha Geopark, the Triassic stratigraphy and marine vertebrate fossil locations (including Malinghe Canyon) in Guizhou Province Route 4: Luoping (Yunnan Province) and Panxian (Guizhou Province) Triassic stratigraphy and marine vertebrate fossil locations in Yunnan Province

Details of the post-symposium excursions will be announced in the second circular. We therefore welcome any comments and suggestions for our proposed arrangements by April 30, 2010.

Call for Abstracts:

All prospective participants are asked to submit an abstract in English (oral and poster) and an abstract book will be published before the conference. The submission deadline is May 31st, 2010. Details regarding the abstract will be announced in the second circular.

Registration:

Registration fee will be \$800 for regular participants, \$500 for students. The registration fee will cover the symposium documents and drinks during the conference.

Travel Arrangements:

Arrangements will be made to transport international attendees from the Guiyang Airport (KWE) to the Guanling Hotel; i.e., you do not have to worry about ground transportation. You are responsible for flying to Guiyang, the capital of Guizhou Province. It is as easy as transferring once at Beijing (PEK) or Shanghai (SHA)--you may easily purchase such tickets through online venders, such as <u>Travelocity</u> and <u>Expedia</u>.
